

## CRCA MANDATORY UNIFORM POLICY 2019-2020

### **Pre-K4 – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade**

- ALL STUDENTS: **MUST** wear ANKLE COVERING SOCKS OR HIGHER.



- ALL STUDENTS: **MUST** wear their uniform shirt tucked in.

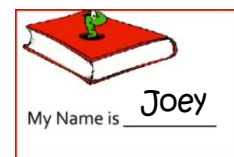


- ALL STUDENTS 1<sup>st</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup>: **MUST** wear a belt every day. **NO BELTS FOR PRESCHOOL STUDENTS.**

- ALL STUDENTS: **MUST** wear uniforms, **including winter wear**, from **AA Uniform**.



- Due to the excessive amount of items that are turned in to our Lost & Found, please make sure you **label all uniform items** including belts, shoes & jackets.



- STUDENTS in 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>: Need to purchase a school PE uniform from CRCA, **ONLY** if they are taking PE as an elective.

- ALL STUDENTS Pre-K4 - 8<sup>th</sup>: School shoes **MUST** be **closed-toe and ankle covering or higher socks must be worn**. They may not have lights or wheels. Boots or shoes above the ankle are **NOT** allowed.

- PRESCHOOL STUDENTS (Pre-K4): **MUST** wear VELCRO or ELASTIC BAND SHOES/SNEAKERS.

### **NO SHOELACES (Pre-K4)**



- ALL BOYS: **MUST** have their tapered haircuts by the first day of school and be maintained throughout the school year.  
**NO EXCEPTIONS!**



- Hair will be neatly trimmed off the eyebrows and collar with the entire ear showing. Our hair code does not permit boys to wear their head shaved on the sides and long on the top. Boys will not be permitted to attend classes with this type of haircut or other faddish or extreme haircuts.
- All male students must be clean shaven **each school day** with no moustache or beard.
- Boys may not wear earrings at school or any other school-related activity. Violation will result in demerits and/or suspension.

### **Additional Dress Code Information**

1. No hats or caps are worn with the uniform or in the building at any time.
2. No extreme haircuts, styles, or color (no shaved designs, mohawks, tails, etc.)
3. No male or female student with dyed hair will be admitted to class, and will remain out until hair is restored to its natural color.
4. The administration reserves the right to deem any hairstyle unacceptable.
5. No more than one piece of neckwear (gold chains, etc) may be worn. Necklaces and chains must be worn inside uniform shirt.
6. No jewelry associated with drug culture may be worn.
7. Ladies may have no more than two earrings per ear and earrings must not be excessive in size or length. Ladies may have no other body piercings.
8. No visible tattoos are allowed for ladies or gentlemen.
9. Writing on the skin is not allowed.

### **Daily Violations**

Students violating the hair code may be asked not to return to class until meeting the hair code. Repeated violations may result in suspension.

Middle School students will receive demerits and/or a detention for dress code violations.

Kindergarten & Elementary: 1<sup>st</sup> violation – A note will be sent home (requiring parent signature).  
2<sup>nd</sup> violation – Parent will be called and asked to bring correct uniform.  
3<sup>rd</sup> violation – Student will receive one misconduct point.

Repeat dress code violations will result in suspension.

## CONTINUED IMPORTANT MANDATORY UNIFORM POLICY

### **\*\*VERY IMPORTANT\*\***

After receiving a written warning, students not in compliance with this policy will not be allowed to remain in the classroom until compliance is met. Middle School students will also be issued demerits if they are not in compliance after receiving a written warning.
